TRUMP II DOMESTIC LANDSCAPE

- Economy
 - Strength, uncertainties
 - Inflation
- Fiscal Crisis
 - Federal spending (24% GDP)
 - National Debt (98% GDP)
 - Annual Deficit \$1.8T (6.4% GDP)

- Republican Governance
 - Three-Legged (Shaky) Stool
 - Executive Branch
 - Senate Majority (53-47)
 - House (nominal) Majority

Limited legislative capacity in a polarized political environment.

Trump Administration relies on Budget Reconciliation, Executive Orders.

BUDGET

- "Skinny" Budget
- Congressional Budget Resolution

\$5.3T tax reduction \$3.8T added to deficit

Expected spending reduction: \$1.5-2T




TAX REFORM AND RETRENCHMENT

Smoke, mirrors, and a looming tax increase.

- Tax Cuts and Jobs Act (TCJA) Reauthorization (forestall massive tax increase) [\$4.5T]
- Business Tax Relief: Expensing, DPAD Restoration, R&D, NCR for Buildings
- Populist: Tips, Overtime, Social Security Tax, Auto Loan Interest, SALT
- Payfors: CSALT, Nonprofits, IRA Green Energy credits, Endowment Tax
